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## Cornucopia with Oval Appliqué Frame



*This is a simple design I auto digitized from clip art and modified slightly. The resulting design has a stencil type vibe. With the included oval appliqué, you can confidently stitch this design on napped or textured towels without fear of having the design sink into the nap of the towel.*

*Hope you have fun with it!*

### Supplies:

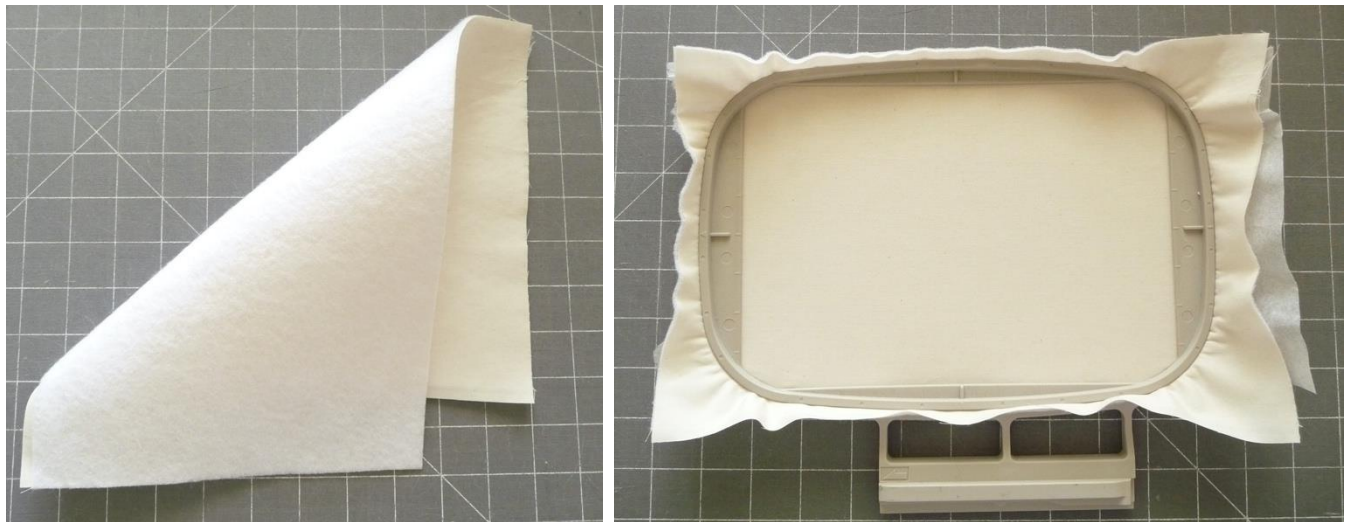
- Ready-made or custom crafted towel. Note that this design is suited for towels with texture.
- Standard 5" X 7" hoop.
- Embroidery threads in colors of choice.
- For appliqué, choose Quilt quality cotton cut to fit 5X7 hoop. Fuse medium weight interfacing (such as Pellon 950F ShirTailor) or fusible craft fleece (such as Pellon 987F), fused to wrong side of fabric. I like the fusible fleece as it gives a little "puff" to the design.
- Medium weight tear-away stabilizer.
- Temporary adhesive spray.
- Sharp scissors for trimming.

*Please read through all instructions before beginning. Design sequence is a bit different than a standard applique stitched directly on fabric. Take care to snip any jump threads as you stitch.*

1. Download Cornucopia design and Oval Appliqué frame design in your desired format. Transfer designs to machine. Build a combination design in the following order:
  - Select cornucopia design.
  - Add lettering as desired.
  - Add Oval appliqué.

Note color change details listed on page 5 for cornucopia design and oval appliqué. Multiple colors are used to show the stops between each segment of the oval. When stitch the appliqué to the towel you can use the same color thread for the placement, tack down, and final satin stitching.

Fuse interfacing or craft fleece to wrong side of fabric. Hoop stabilized fabric.



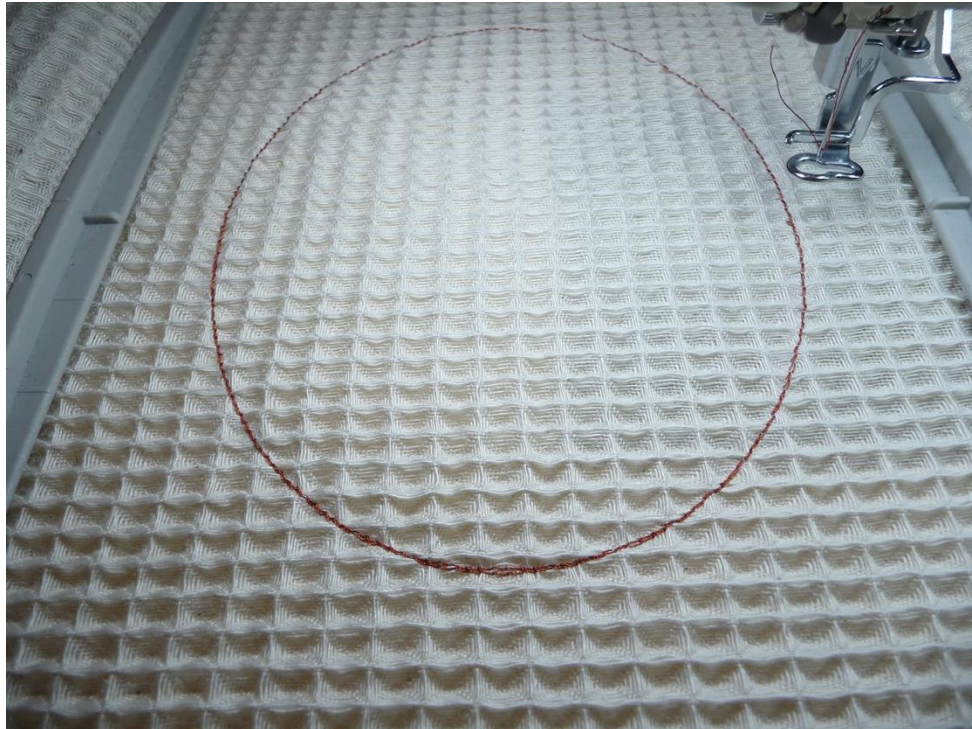
Stitch cornucopia and lettering. Stitch the first segment of the oval appliqué.



2. Remove from hoop and carefully remove excess tear-away stabilizer. Next, trim just outside the oval stitching line.



3. Hoop towel, centering for placement of the oval appliqué. Slip a piece of tear away under the hoop to support the appliqué stitching. Stitch placement line for the appliqué piece.



4. Lightly spray wrong side of embroidered oval appliqué and layer trimmed oval over the placement line.



5. Stitch remaining color segments, (tack down & satin stitching) using the thread color you chose for the final appliqué stitching. You are finished! Enjoy!

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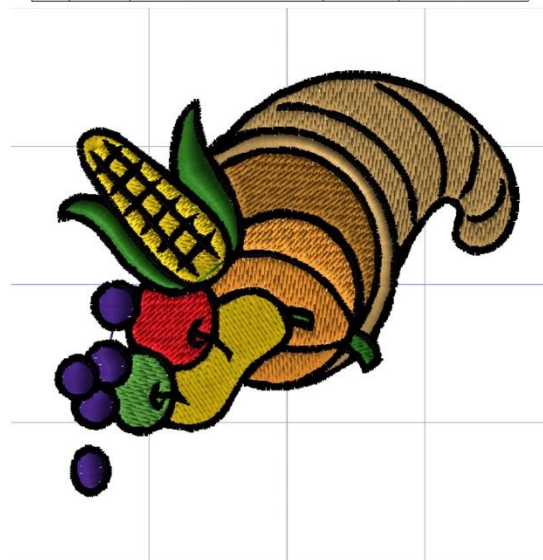


