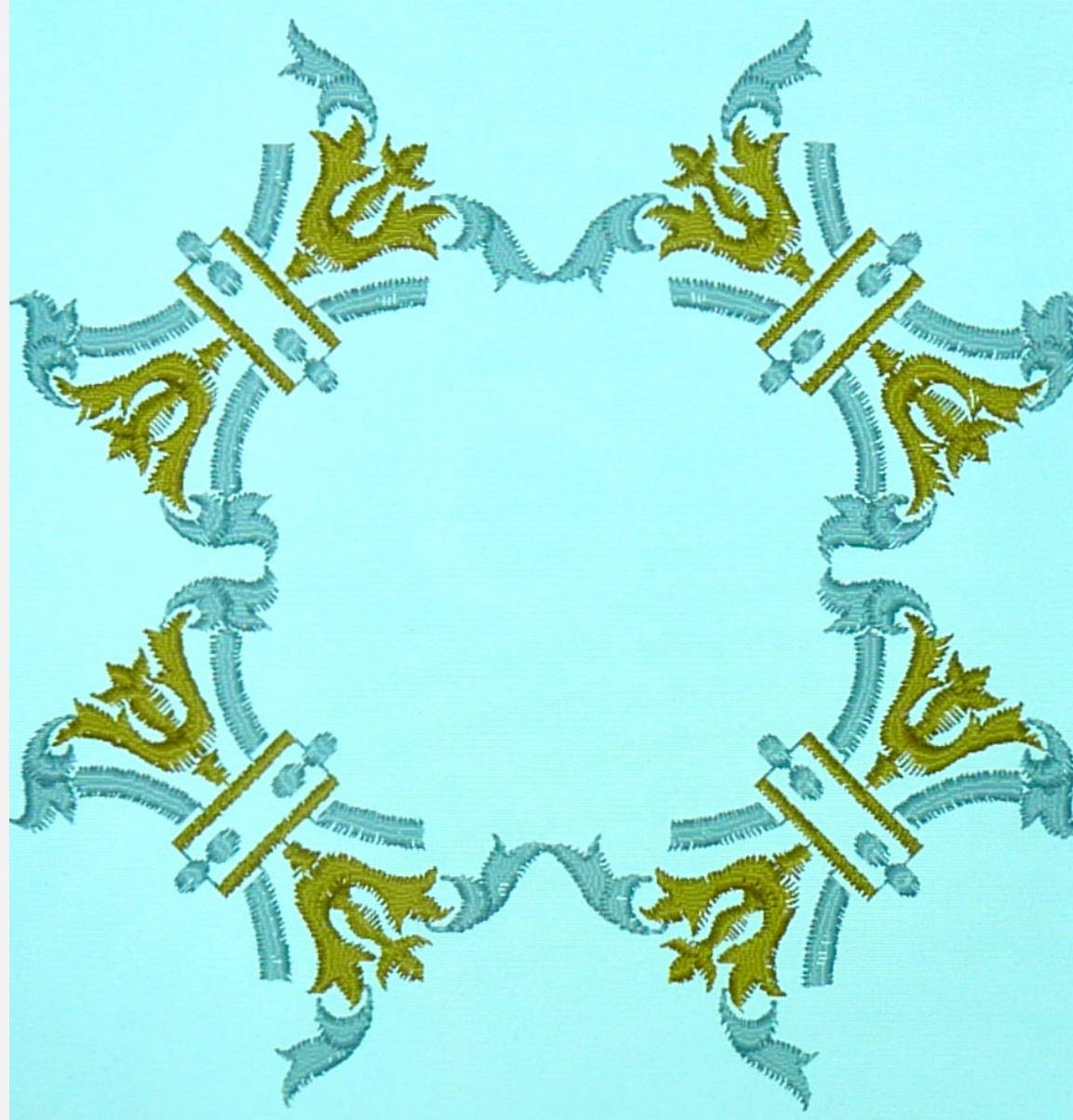


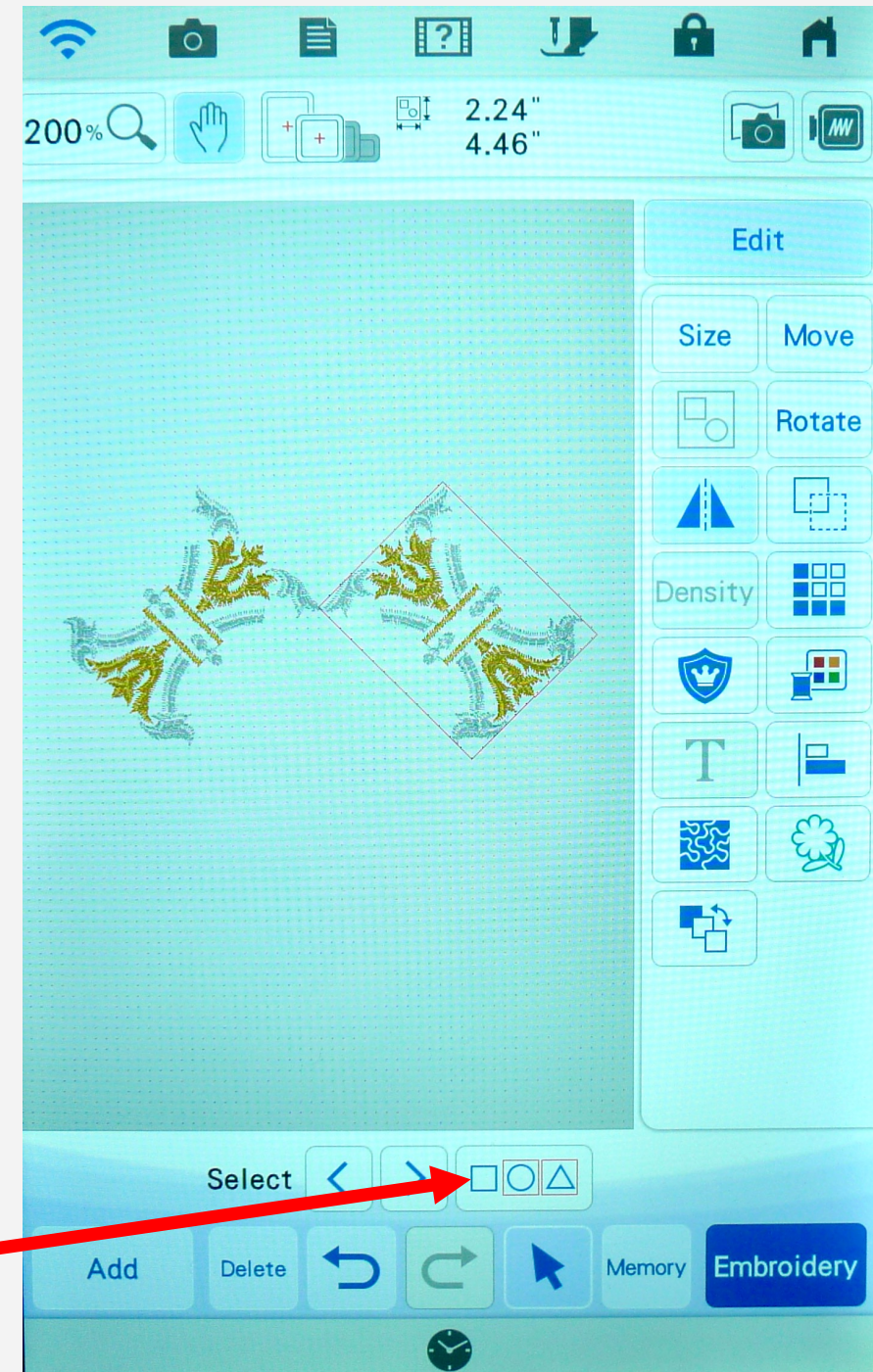
In this demo the goal is to create a monogram frame like the one below, using the grouping key and multiple pattern selection features in the Brother Luminaire.

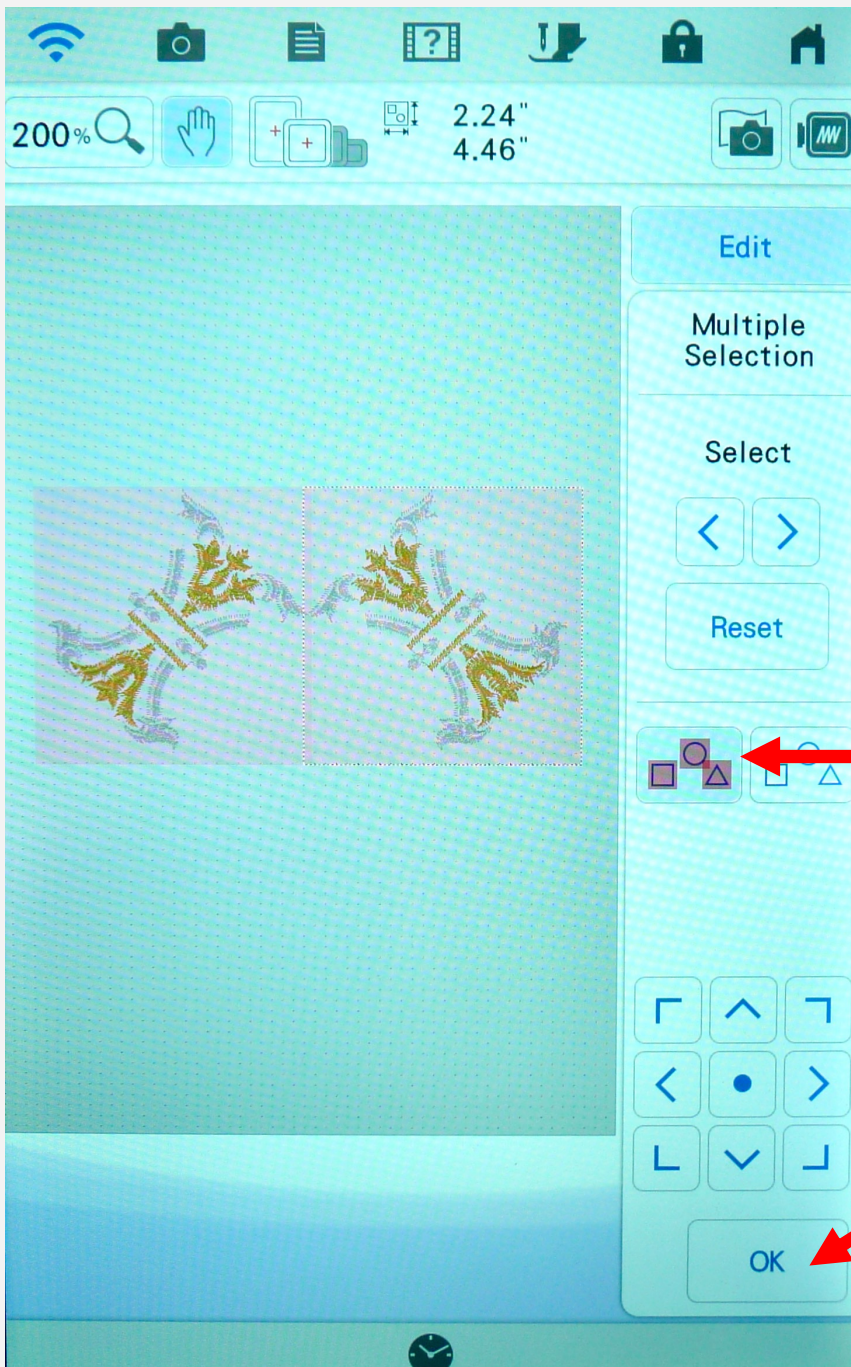


The first two motifs are already rotated, mirror imaged, and perfectly positioned.

Next, we'll create matching pieces for the second half of the frame.

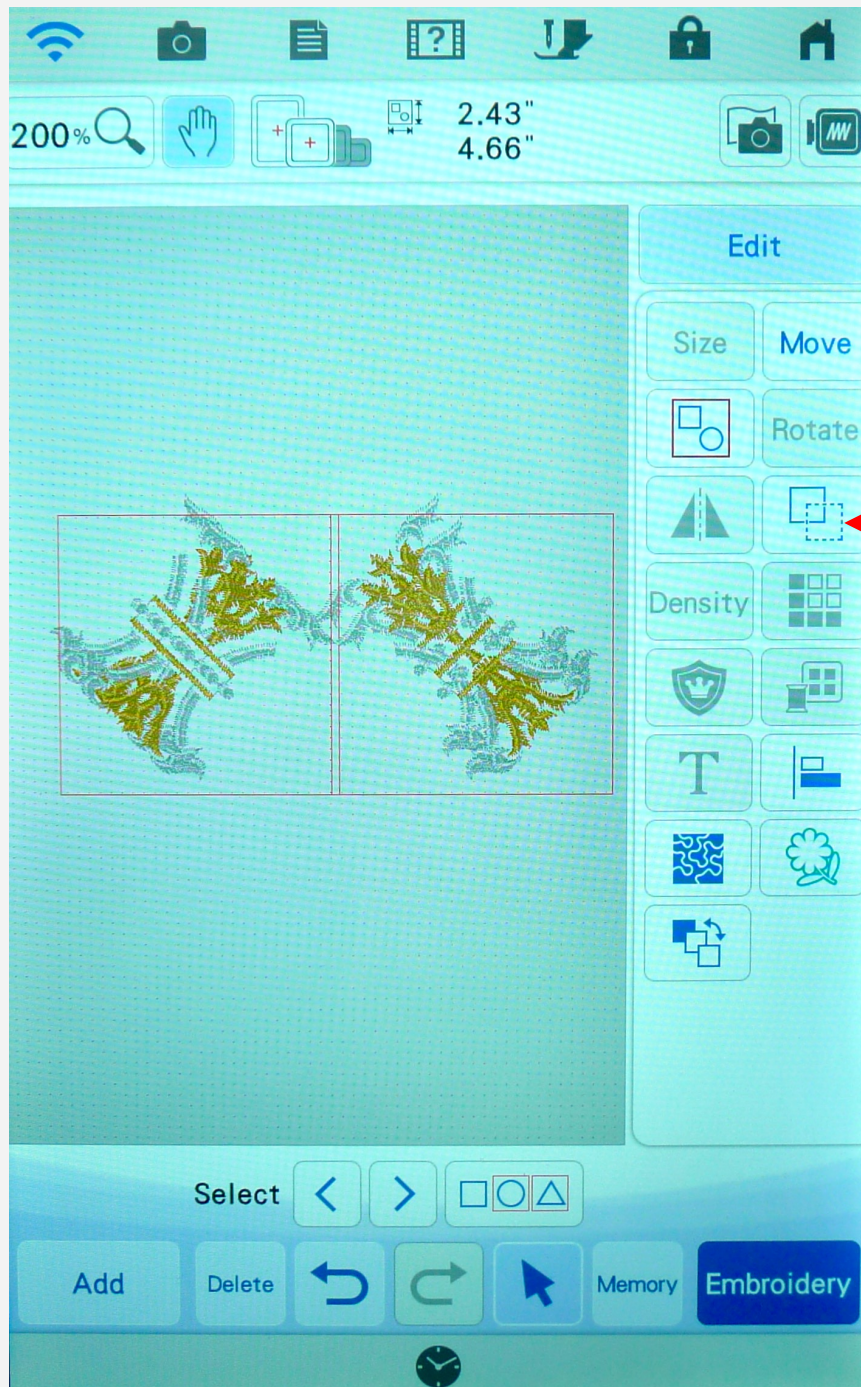
Touch the key for selecting multiple motifs.



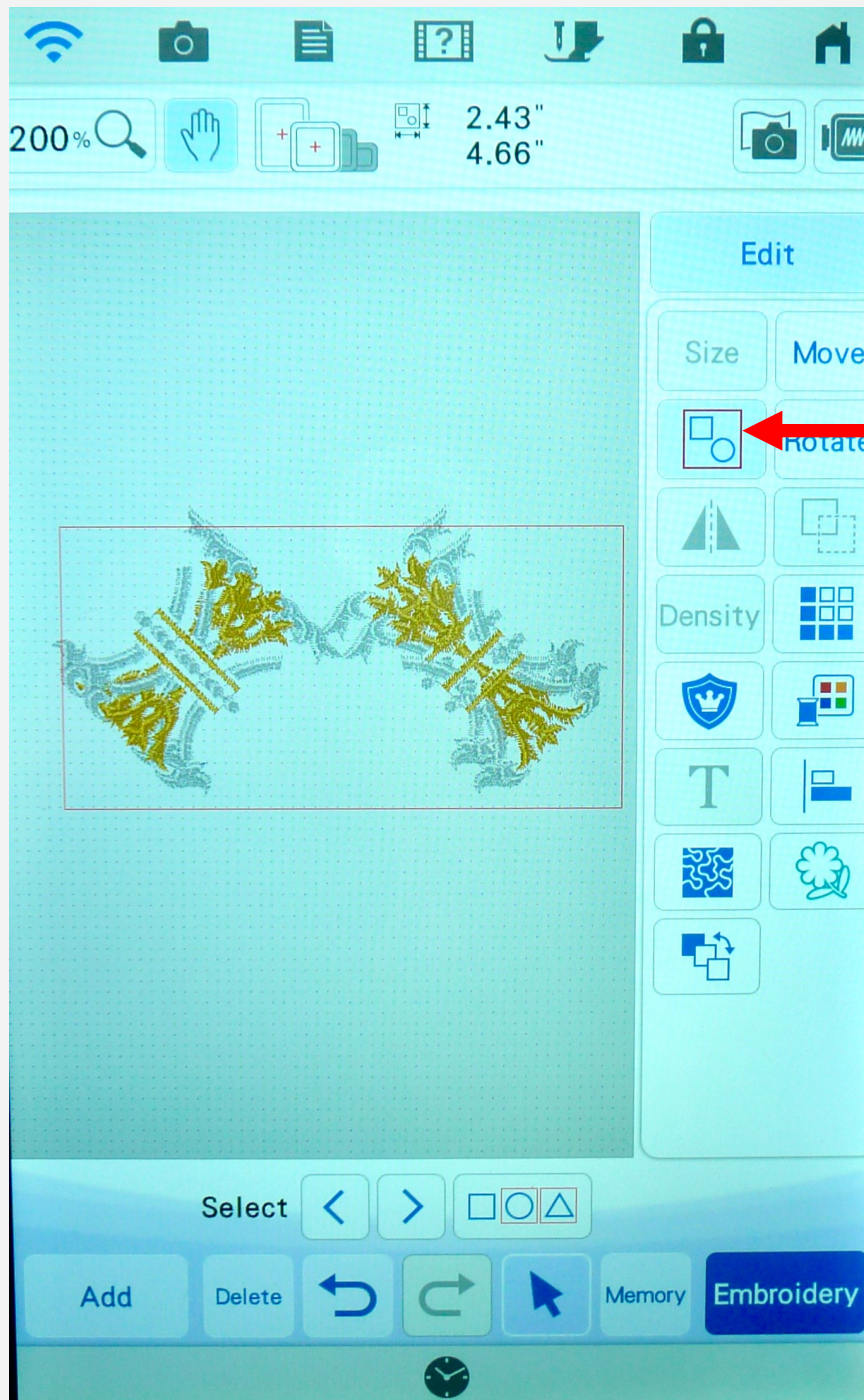


Touch the selection key to select all motifs in the pattern display area. This groups the two together together as one unit.

Touch OK.

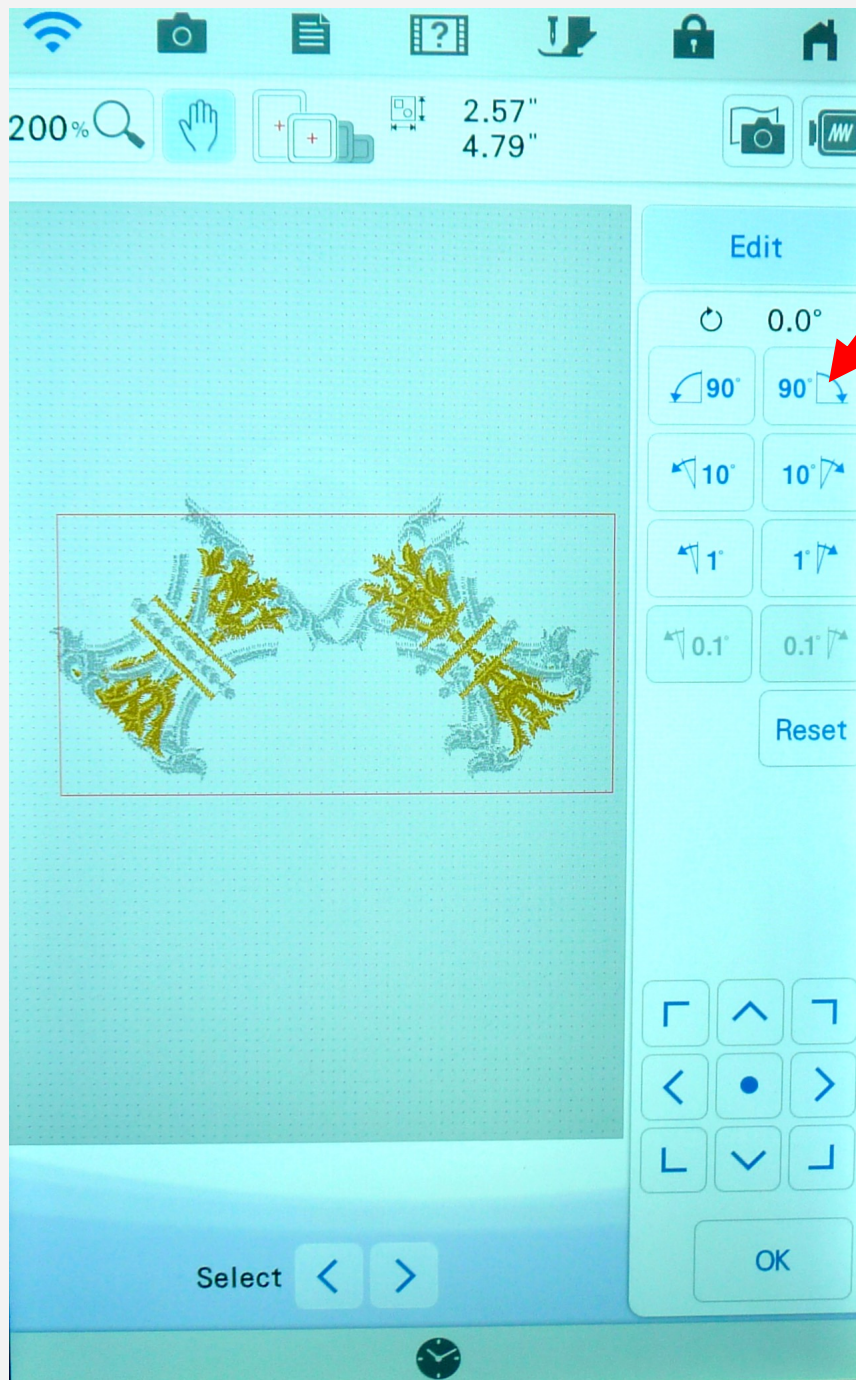


Next, touch the duplicate key to create a second set of matching motifs.



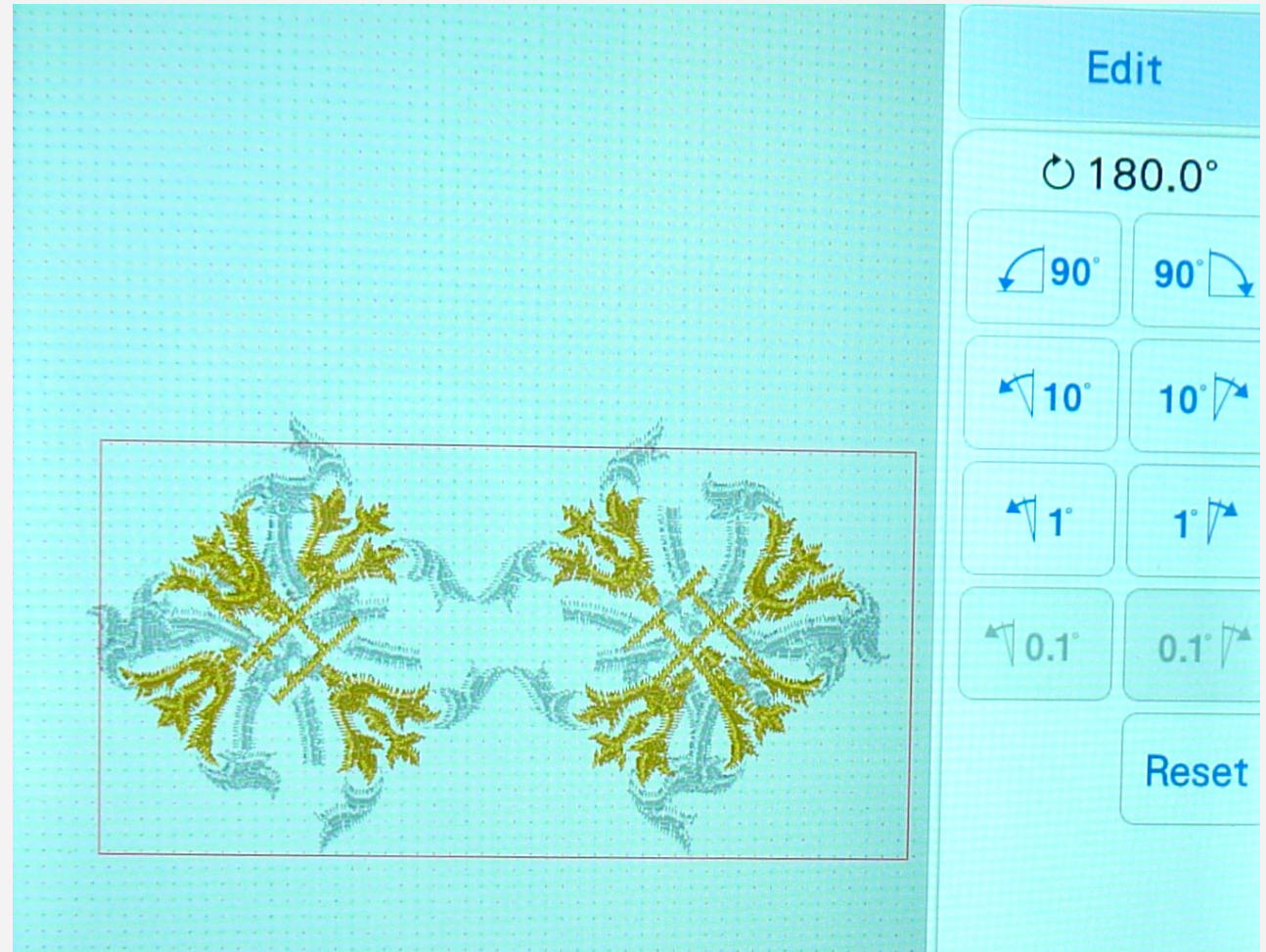
Touch the group key to edit these duplicated motifs as one unit.

Note that the group key is now highlighted.

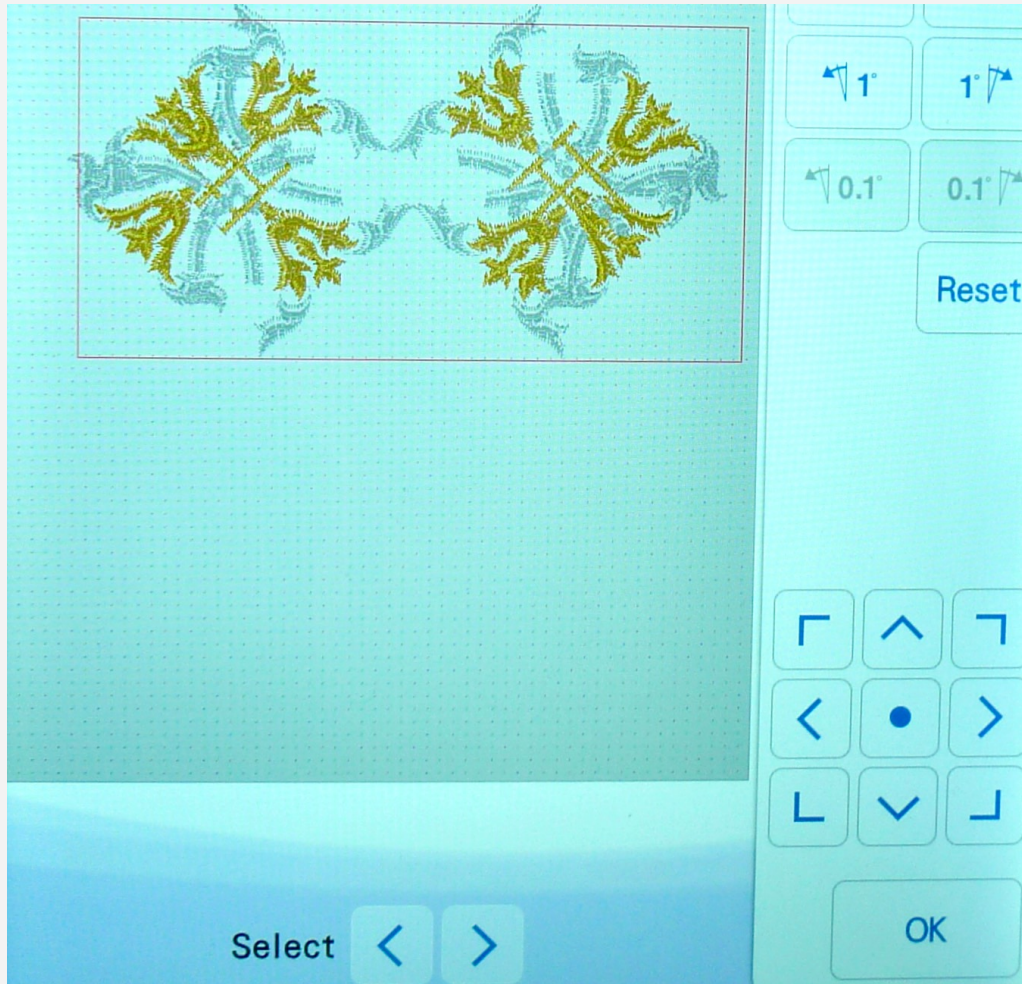


Touch the rotate key, then touch the key to rotate 90 degrees to the right, touching this key twice to rotate grouped motifs a total of 180 degrees.

See my example of the rotated motifs below:

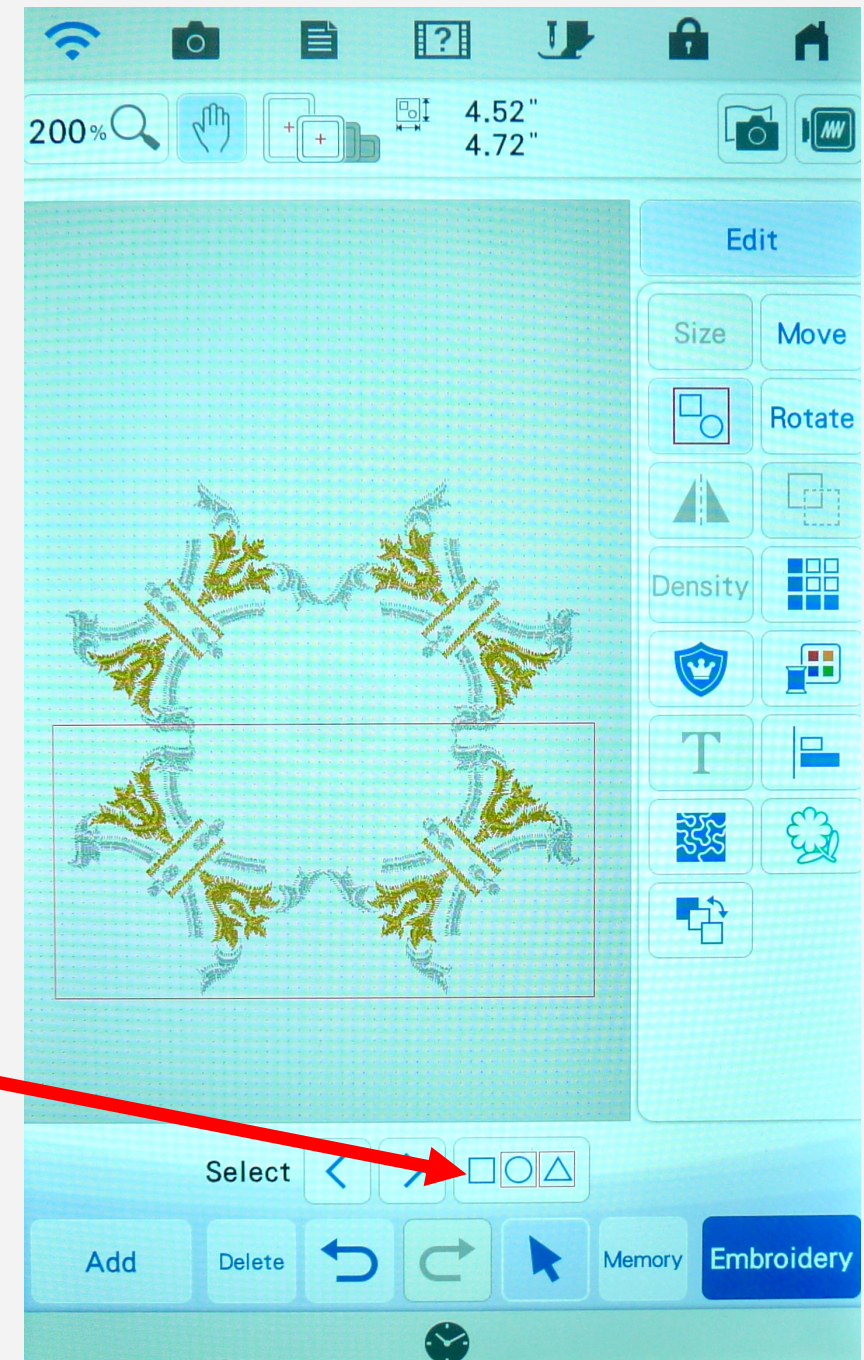


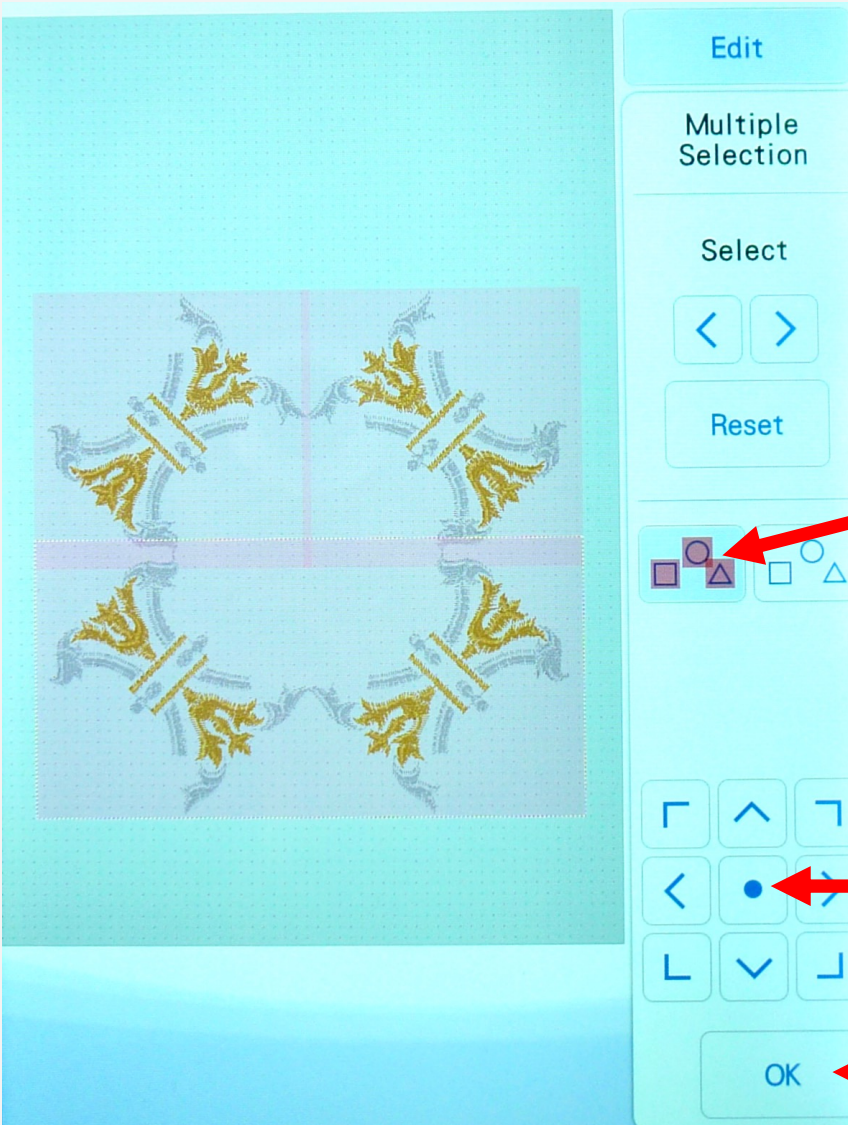
Use arrow keys to move the second set of motifs into position.



Touch OK when you're happy with the location of the motifs.

Next, touch the key for selecting multiple motifs.





Touch the selection key to select all four motifs on the screen.

Next, touch the centering key to send this group to the center of the design page.

Touch OK.
